K-3 Supply List

- 1 regular sized backpack able to hold a folder without bending (no toddler backpacks)
- 1 kindergarten, blue and red nap mat (no fat mats) - If your child stays after 12pm
- 1 small receiving blanket or beach towel for nap time (no large blankets)
- 1 sturdy plastic folder
- 3 boxes - 8 count "Kid's First" Crayola brand washable (triangular) crayons
- 1 box - 8 count Crayola washable markers (classic colors)
- 2 Colored dry erase markers
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 plastic pencil box (no more than 3 ½" tall)
- 2 containers of Play-Doh brand play dough
- 3 coloring books
- 1 pack of construction paper (boys)
- 1 pack of white or bright colored card stock (girls)
- 2 packs of baby wipes
- 1 container of clorox wipes
- 2 cubes of kleenex tissues

Tennis shoes with velcro straps (no strings)

*Due to emptying shoes of sand after recess and some taking off shoes for nap, it is more efficient to have velcro strapped shoes that children can manage to slip on and off with ease.

Crayons, scissors, dry erase markers, and glue stick should be placed in pencil box with child's name on it. Play dough, coloring book, and mat should also be labeled with child's name in black permanent marker. Please bring all items on Orientation night so that everything can be organized by the first day of school. Don't forget your SMILE :)

*All jackets, blankets, backpacks, etc. must be labeled. Extra change of clothes kept in a clear zip lock bag (with child's name on the bag) inside their backpack.

K-4 Supply List

- 1 kindergarten nap mat (no fat mats please) small blanket or beach towel. Please no large fleece blankets, and no pillows please.
- 1 containers of clorox wipes
- 1 pack of crayola watercolor paint
- 1 box of small zip lock bags
- 1 box of large zip lock bags
- 1 container of baby wipes

Additional items needed for class:

Skittles, stickers, treasure chest items, m&m's, other soft candy, (no suckers), and art supplies

Please label all school supplies with your child's name and place in their pencil box. Extra change of clothes need to be in a clear zip lock with your child's name on it, and kept inside of their book bag at all times.

Please bring all items labeled on Orientation night so that everything can be organized by the first day of school.

Important:

First Grade Supply List

Additional items needed for classroom:

- 2 vinyl folders with pockets (these are sturdier and will last the entire year)
- 1 Wide-ruled composition notebook
- 1 ½" Binder for science activity manual (1" is too small & 2" too large for desk)
- 1 package of crayons--24 count only
- 1 package of colored pencils--12 count only
- 1 wood ruler with inches and centimeters
- 2 red ink pens
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 small size glue sticks
- 1 small pencil box
- 1 large container disinfectant wipes (no multi-packs due to limited storage space)
- 1 container of hand/baby wipes
- 1 large box of tissues

Please bring all listed items with your child on Orientation night so that everything is organized and ready for the first day of school. All personal items should be marked with your child's first name using a permanent marker (this includes pencils).

Scissors, pencils, red pens, crayons, colored-pencils, large eraser and glue sticks should be placed in the pencil box with your child's name on it (no extra supplies please). Folders, composition notebook, and 1 ½" binder should also be labeled with your child's name in black permanent marker.

PLACE PENCILS (5), ALL ERASERS, GLUE STICKS, PENS, CRAYONS, HIGHLIGHTER, 1 MARKER AND SCISSORS IN PENCIL BAG. PLACE 1 PACK OF NOTEBOOK PAPER, INDEX DIVIDERS WITH TABS, AND FOLDERS IN 1 NOTEBOOK. ALL OTHER ITEMS WILL BE STORED IN THE ROOM.
